Acupuncture

Acupuncture is a branch of Oriental Medicine used in Asia for thousands of years. There, it has been and continues to be used as a primary source of medical care to treat a wide variety of ailments. It involves insertion of thin, sterilized, disposable needles into specific points on the body to stimulate the healing response.

Chunchieh Bruce Sun, CAc, MSOM, Dipl OM, is a state certified acupuncturist, holds a Master of Science in Oriental Medicine, and is a Diplomate of Oriental Medicine with the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture & Oriental Medicine. He sees children (beginning age 6) and adult patients of all ages.

Fees: New Client \$90, Established Client \$65 per session.

Classical Homeopathy

Homeopathy begins with the understanding that the body, mind and emotions work as an integrated whole. Clients of all ages are treated for most physical, mental, and emotional conditions.

David A. Johnson, CCH, is a Certified Classical Homeopath whose interest in homeopathy began after working 12 years as a Physician Assistant.

Fees: New Client \$375; includes follow-up appointment/scheduled 1-3 months after initial appointment. Established Client \$95 per session. Services are offered for ages 0-adult. Child & young adult fees vary depending upon age. Contact office for details.

Psychotherapy

Psychotherapy provides support and treatment of mental or emotional maladjustment by means involving verbal communication between a therapist and individual, couple or family. Our therapist will help create a new plan and explore the blocks that effectively recycle suffering. Anxiety, depression, grief, addiction, stress, PTSD, marriage/relationship struggles are among many conditions for which the therapist can help you find practical solutions and discover the nature of true happiness.

Fees: \$140 per 50-minute session.

Reiki/Therapeutic Yoga/Physical Therapy

Reiki is a hands-on energy healing technique, effective in treating stress and tension-related disorders, pain, chronic fatigue, migraines, and a host of other problems. It supports your body's natural healing abilities and promotes mind/body awareness.

Therapeutic Yoga blends Physical Therapy knowledge & experience with the wisdom of yoga to create a personalized healing practice for your specific needs. This is great treatment protocol when recovering from an injury, illness, or for chronic conditions.

Group Yoga – Beginner/Intermediate Weekly Yoga Classes offered at Ommani. Emphasis is on breath, alignment, and honoring your body.

Physical Therapy – Focuses on restoration of proper postural alignment. Hands-on treatment is combined with instruction for an in-home program utilizing breathwork and yoga poses to restore pain-free function. (MD order required.)

Shelley Carpenter, PT, RYT, RM is a Physical Therapist; she is also a Registered Yoga Teacher, and Reiki Master/Teacher.

Fees: Reiki - \$70 per 60-minute session. Therapeutic Yoga and/or Physical Therapy - \$75 per 60-minute session. Group Yoga fees are available on the website.

Payments may be made via VISA, MasterCard, Discover, Check, Cash, and/or with most Flexible Spending Account (FSA)/Health Savings Account (HSA) plan debit cards.

Genevie L. Kocourek, M.D. specializes in Family Medicine. **Dr. Kocourek** accepts and is an in-network provider for most traditional/commercial, group, and individual insurance contracts, including some Wisconsin (Affordable Care Act) Healthcare Exchange programs. We file claims on the patients' behalf for in-network insurance benefits. We advise that you check with your insurance carrier to be certain Dr. Kocourek is within your specific insurance network.

Fees: Medical doctor (M.D.) fees are not quoted herewith and vary depending upon services provided.
